The way of the event to deal with rural life and the development of rural regions has an unusual way, but get on board and see what happens. „Ein-Weites-Feld-Forum“ is designed as a platform to facilitate the exchange of experiences between initiatives and actors in rural areas and to support their networking. The „focus“ of the event is located in the wide field of cultural, artistic and social interventions that deal with the advancement of rural society and its values as well as their habitat and their environment.

The „Ein-Weites-Feld-Forum“ wants to invite you to two program points to inform yourself, to discuss and to reflect in an unusual way. The two program points are:

Workshop „Home (at)advantage“ with walks in March (March 13-14, 2014): This program point is designed as an open workshop which focusses the dialogue between the event guests and residents of the Havelregion. We expect interested guests from diverse disciplines. Common walks and perhaps more „normal“ activities in the villages intend to support dialogues with the place, the people and the rural life to share ideas, discuss and to make new contacts.

„Ein-Weites-Feld-Markt“ (March 15, 2014 - afternoon)

At the „A wide-field-market“ cultural, artistic and social activities in rural areas of Germany and Europe will be presented in brief presentations. Then there is the possibility to discuss the activities presented at „market stalls“ with the speakers. Furthermore, the personal experiences and impressions from the workshop „Home (at)advantage“ are described in brief summaries, thereby giving additional input for dialogues and discussions on the market.

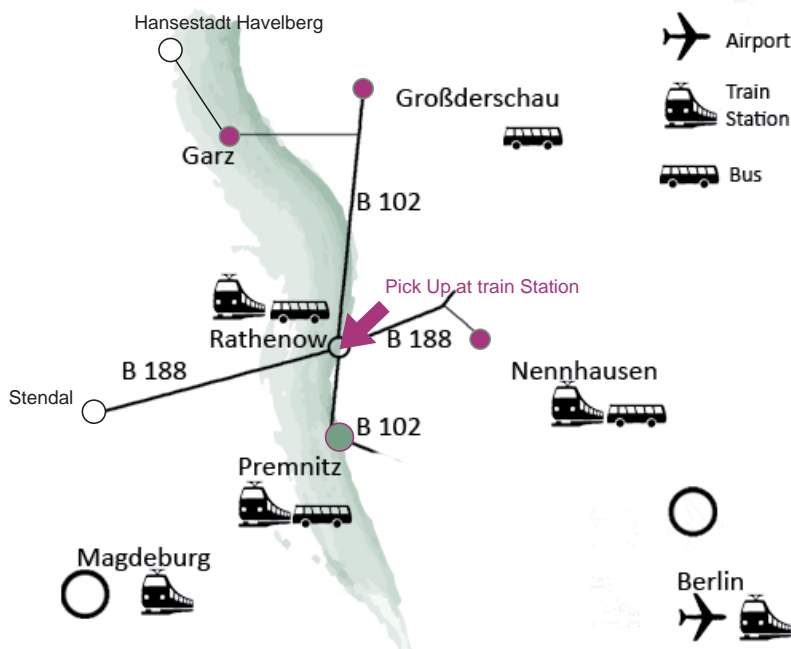
